*We await the results from the competition organisers.*

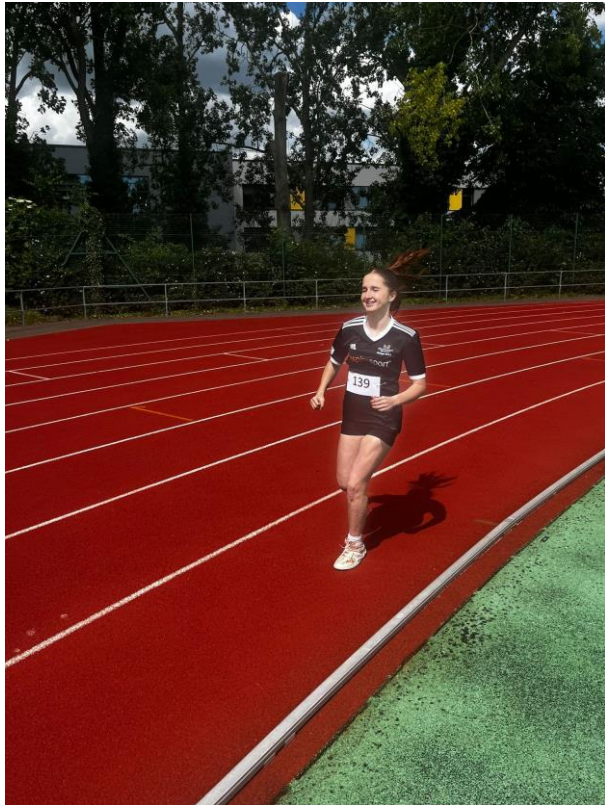
