Transition Days – Monday 01 and Tuesday 02 July 2024

We are looking forward to welcoming your child to our Transition days on Monday 01 and Tuesday 02 July 2024. Students should arrive at the school, dressed in their current uniform at 8.30am. A school meal will be provided on Monday for your child; however, students should bring in extra snacks and water to keep them going throughout the day.

On Tuesday, please send your child to school with a packed lunch and extra snacks for breaktime. *(Please refrain from bringing nuts and nut products into school as part of their packed lunch.)*

A school bag will be essential on both days, to carry their pencil case, snacks, trainers, a jacket in case of inclement weather and any essential medication that has been previously agreed with our Medical Administrator.

Letters regarding how to log on to ParentPay will be sent home with your child on one of these Transition Days.

Students who qualify for a bus pass do not need to have bus passes during the two transition days, as the bus companies are expecting them. However, students who do not qualify, and plan to use public transport on the two days will need to pay.
