For students in Key Stage 3 we report on Attainment Statements and Effort (Attitude to Learning) Level for each subject – please see the *Key Stage 3 Progress, Attainment and Achievement Guidance*. Students in Key Stage 4 will have a target grade, a professional predicted grade and an effort (Attitude to Learning) Level. Please see explanations below.

Effort

The following levels will give you an idea of the effort your child is committing to their studies. Hard work really does pay off and every year we see that the most successful students, those who meet and exceed their targets, are those who put all that they can into their studies. The goal for each student should really be to achieve 5's for effort grades in all of their subjects.

Effort	Description
1	Very little effort shown in lessons. Regularly off-task. Behaviour may disrupt own and others learning. Shows very little motivation. Very poor attitude to learning
2	Some effort is shown in lessons, but this is inconsistent and there is behaviour that sometimes disrupts own or others learning. A better attitude to learning is required.
3	Appropriate effort is being shown in lessons. Behaviour is positive and motivation and attitude to learning is at an acceptable level.
4	Good effort, behaviour, motivation and attitude are shown in lessons.
5	Excellent effort in every lesson. Strives to carry out tasks to the very best of their ability. Excellent behaviour, motivation and attitude to learning.





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Target

The target grade for the end of Yr11 is a long-range target based upon the results of Key Stage 2 attainment, a national measure produced by the Department for Education.

PPG (Professional Predicted Grade)

The PPG grade is a grade that your child's teacher has predicted they will achieve at the end of Yr11 if they continue to progress as they currently are.
