Results

Results will be available to you in two ways:

In person-you can collect results from 9am on Thursday 22nd August. Students must be off site by 11am

Online- Results will be available online from 10am via the Go4Schools website.

If a student cannot collect their results and would like a family member to do so, they must notify us in advance in writing, informing us who they have given permission for collection to.

Certificates

Certificates will be issued at a later date. Exam Boards usually send these to the school in November.

Post Results Services

If a student feels that there has been a mistake made in the marking of any of their papers or their grades affect their decisions about what to do next in education, training or work they should discuss this with the school.

Teachers, the Futures Co-ordinator and the Exams Officer will be in school on Results Day to give advice.

Review of Marking * -Exam boards review their marking to ensure your work was marked accurately in line with the mark scheme

Clerical Re-Check -Exam boards re-check that all marks have been included and added up correctly.

It is important that you understand that marks could go up or down or stay the same as part of these checks.

The school can also ask the exam board to provide a copy of the exam papers to help us decide what to do next.

You will be asked to give permission for this by signing a form on Results Day after you collect your results.

* If your overall grade goes up as a result of a RoM - you will not be charged and payment will be refunded to you.
