KS4 Options process

Year 9 students are starting the process of selecting their GCSE and BTEC options for Year 10. This is the most important stage in your child's education so far and we understand it can be an anxious time. Making the right decisions and choices is of vital importance. In Key Stage 4, they will be focused on the subjects/qualifications they are studying and preparing for their examinations in Year 11. They will be taking courses that will help them to prepare for further study, maybe on an A-Level/Level 3 course at Sixth Form or at college, through an apprenticeship or studying T-Levels.

You will have received a booklet to guide you and your child through the subjects and courses available and to help you make an informed choice regarding the optional subjects your child may wish to study. The choices they make will help to shape their future not only for the next two years, but also in later life.
