**Dear Families** 

All students in Year 10 are going to be on Work Experience from Monday 12<sup>th</sup> to Friday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2025. For all those students who find a placement in this period there will be no classes, each day all students will be at the workplace of their host employer.

Work Experience gives students the chance to learn about what type of job they might enjoy, and develop their CV. We know from experience that it can be one of the most transformational experiences for young people.

Students (and their families) should **source their own work experience placements**. The careers team and your child's PSHE teacher will do their best to help students contact potential employers about placements, however, the expectation is that students have at least tried to find a placement before seeking support, we have limited resources, so will only be able to help a small number of students.

Any students who are **unable to find a placement are expected to be in school as usual** for the full week, and any student who fails to attend school that week will be marked as an unauthorised absence.

We are using Unifrog (<a href="www.unifrog.org">www.unifrog.org</a>) to manage the administration of the work experience programme – for example collecting information from the employer about their Risk Assessment, Insurance, and Health & Safety policy, as well as getting agreement from yourselves for the placement to go ahead. All emails regarding work experience will therefore come from Unifrog and not the school's email system, so please check your spam folders once your child has confirmed that they have submitted their placement details on Unifrog.

## Some important logistics:

- Students need to agree the placement with the employer **first** and then students will get the ball rolling by adding the placement to their Unifrog account (they'll find the Placements tool on their Unifrog homepage)
- The Unifrog system will then email the employer, the parent/guardian and the school, to
  collect the necessary information and permissions. For the process to work, it is essential
  that students add the initial information about the placement accurately. Do not forget all
  emails will be coming from Unifrog and not the school email system
